

PALOMAR DEAD and DYING TREE REMOVAL PROJECT

Grant funding provided by the United States Forest Service

This funding will be directed at the removal of dead and dying trees in the communities of Crestline and Birch Hill.

The project will target trees which are within 150 feet of any legally permitted structure. The resulting wood will be processed and utilized as firewood, milled timber, and mulch from chips.

The general timeline will be as follows:

WINTER 2024-2025	Inform community and gather Temporary Entry Permits from residents.
WINTER-SPRING 2025	Survey properties and strategize work.
SPRING-SUMMER 2025	Begin cutting and processing trees.
