EFHOA Board of Directors Election

We would like to take this opportunity to encourage your participation in the Everett Farms Homeowners' Association (EFHOA) by serving as a member of the Board of Directors. The election of three (3) directors will take place in conjunction with the association's Annual Meeting which will be held on Monday, November 8, 2021.

The Board is comprised of nine members and duties include: welcoming new residents, setting the annual homeowners' fees, overseeing the expenses of the association, and helping to maintain the quality of the neighborhood through service on one or more committees (architectural/landscaping, grounds, or outreach).

Director terms are for three years and a director whose term expires can apply for another three-year term.

Board meetings typically take place 3 to 4 times per year, and the time commitment is minimal. Some of the board's business is conducted via e-mail and due to Covid-19 board members have been given the option of attending meetings in-person or participating online.

Be a Good Neighbor

Please make it a priority to store these containers inside or in an appropriate enclosure on the same day as your pick-up.
