RE: PROGRESS REPORT FOR JULY, 2025

This report is to inform the Board of Directors and the public at large of the progress and future plans for development of Jordan Lake Park in central Big Lake. The progress to date has been paid for with private donations and grants. Future planned development and the dates of construction will depend on available funding. The actual design and placement of structures within the park are subject to future design and planning, which are still open to change.

WORK ON JLP TO DATE:

- Initial clearing and rough leveling of 5 acre site in Southeast corner of JLP.
- Installation of approximately 400 feet of cedar split rail fencing along the Big Lake Road bike path frontage.
- Informational Bulletin Board installed at entrance off park parking lot.

WORK TO BE DONE 2025:

- Clearing of rock from approximately 4 acres of the site, preparation/leveling of soccer field and hydroseeding of park.
- Planting of 25 flowering trees, shrubs and flowers along the cedar rail fencing, installation of signage establishing a "Veterans' Memorial Garden."
- Installation of a packed gravel walking/jogging/ xc skiing trail around the perimeter of the 5 acre site.

WORK TO BE DONE 2025—2026:

- Construction of Recreational courts (2 Basketball, 2 Pickleball and 2 Bocce Ball courts).
- Construction of 2 picnic pavilions.
- Construction of brick "Sponsors' entry, driveway and gate.
- Installation of "Jordan Lake Park "Pioneers" Donor Recognition Sign.
- Construction of 8—12 station "Fitness Course" around perimeter of 5 acre site.
- Construction of outdoor ampitheater (approximately 200 seats) and stage.
- Construction/installation of small playground.

WORK TO BE DONE 2026—2027:

- Permanent Pit Toilet(s), Drinking fountain(s), Barbeque Pits, Bike Rack, etc.
- Trail to wetlands and lake.
- Infrastructure improvements—electrical lines, water lines, lighting, fencing, signage, landscaping, etc.
- · Community Garden.

The design and development of the remaining area of Jordan Lake Park is subject to public input and future planning. It is hoped that the community of Big Lake will become involved in the design and construction of the park so that it may reflect the needs and desires of the community.
