BURMA ROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Matanuska-Susitna Borough **PROJECT NOTICE**

Dear Resident,

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough is beginning field work to support the design of a road improvement project in your area. This notice is to inform you of upcoming activities and what to expect.

What's Happening

As part of the design process, contractors working on behalf of the Borough will be conducting field work that may include:

- Land surveying and topographic mapping
- Test pit digging and geotechnical investigations

This work is necessary to gather data that will inform the design and permitting of the project.

Where

The project area is located off Burma Road, approximately 0.9 miles from W Ayrshire Avenue, south of Big Lake, Alaska. Field work will occur along Burma Road between Carpenter Lake and Moore Road, including adjacent rights-of-way and easements.

A map of the project limits is provided on the back of this notice.

When

Field work is expected to begin the week of March 2nd and continue intermittently through late April. Work may occur on weekdays between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM.

What to Expect

- Crews and staff may be on foot or in vehicles, wearing high-visibility clothing.
- Work may occur on or near private property but will remain within the public right-of-way or authorized access areas.
- Geotechnical work may involve excavators.
- Crews will take care to minimize disruption and restore any disturbed areas as needed.


Benefits

This field work is the first step in designing road improvements that will benefit the community by:


- Increasing vehicle safety
