<b>2</b>	<b>Apologies:</b> SP and Penny Knight (PK).	
<b>3</b>	<b>Minutes</b> of the previous meeting on 13 <sup>th</sup> October were approved.	
<b>4</b>	<b>Matters arising from minutes:</b> The OOM information is now on the notice board.	
<b>5</b>	<b>Treasurer's Report:</b> There is £955.77 in the bank and £242.30 in cash giving a total of £1208.07. The 9 hole twos kitty balance of £48 has been absorbed into funds to put towards the Christmas lunch. There is an outstanding invoice for £24 for AGM refreshments. Jon Shimmons is still having problems connecting with the bank to approve payments.	
<b>6</b>	<b>Committee Organisation.</b> CG shared a revised list of committee members' roles. JW will assist CG, act as social secretary and support PK who has been appointed competitions secretary. Other roles have been updated but not changed.	Members to review the structure and notify CG of any concerns.
<b>7</b>	<b>Christmas Lunch:</b> 26 payments for the Christmas lunch have already been made online and two payments have been promised by cheque. Welcome drinks will be from 1pm and the meal will follow at 1.30pm. Sparkling wine, alcohol free wine and orange juice will be offered. The (9 hole) turkey trot was discussed and MT put forward the suggestion of a Florida Scramble. Each team member hits a tee shot, the best is then chosen as the point from which the whole team, except the person who hit that ball, play their next balls.
