3	Approval of the minutes from the last meeting: The minutes from the meeting on 2 nd February 2026 were approved.	
4	Matters arising from minutes: The Parkin Cup organisers proved difficult to contact and in the end it became necessary to enter the competition before it was possible to organise a meaningful poll. A notice will be put up in the changing room.	
5	Treasurer's Report: There is £833.37 in the bank and £158.51 in cash giving a total of £991.88, which includes the charity donation of £25. A £200 deposit to Golf Breaks will be repaid in due course and £20 has yet to be paid out in respect of the Parkin Cup entry. The true balance is, therefore, £11466.88. Due to an excessively wet spell it has only been possible to play competitive golf on one Wednesday since the beginning of the year.
