The Smart Repair Priority System

Many homeowners accidentally spend money fixing cosmetic issues first. The smart approach is protecting the structure and safety of the home before anything else.

- **Priority 1 – Safety:** electrical hazards, gas issues, structural problems.
- **Priority 2 – Water Intrusion:** plumbing leaks, roof damage, drainage issues.
- **Priority 3 – Core Systems:** HVAC, water heaters, electrical panels.
- **Priority 4 – Efficiency:** insulation, windows, airflow.
- **Priority 5 – Cosmetic:** paint, fixtures, upgrades.

Practical Homeowner Checks

Check During Rain: When it rains, walk through your home and look at ceilings, corners, and walls. Water damage often starts small. Catching a leak early can mean a simple repair instead of thousands in structural damage.

Listen for Water: If you hear water running when nothing is on, there may be a hidden leak. Small leaks can quietly cause mold, rot, and expensive repairs.

Electrical Warning Signs: Flickering lights, warm outlets, or breakers tripping should not be ignored. Electrical issues rarely fix themselves.

Watch Cracks: Small cracks in Tucson homes can be normal due to soil movement, but cracks that grow over time may signal foundation movement.

Service Your AC Early: Tucson summers push air conditioning systems to their limits. Servicing your system before peak heat helps prevent breakdowns in extreme temperatures.
