Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Update

Mending to Ascend Central South District Update Report - Sep 1, 2021

Program Objective: The Central South District DEI initiative aims to mobilize our area churches to provide resources and form the relationships needed to break through the negative impacts of increased exposure to crime and violent behavior throughout our region. By examining our own stereotypes, learning new strategies for promoting mental health and developing individual plans for community engagement, the churches throughout the CSD will work toward establishing ministries that lead to the establishment of healthy leaders, healthy families, healthy churches and healthy communities.

Program Components offered in August 2021:

Launch Event – A 90-minute Zoom introduction to the program components and reflection on how social determinants of health aid us in promoting overall well-being.

64 total attendees

Harvest Respect Trainings: 3 topics covered, aimed at internal examination of how assumptions, stereotypes and biases interfere with our ability to form community and strategies for entering community for the sake of promoting equity.

August Training Session – First Impressions | Unraveling Bias total of five sessions offered, 75 total participants. Participants included Senior Pastors, Associate Pastors and Lay Leaders from 50 of our CSD Churches

What's Next?

September is a month of reflection and processing. There will be two zoom gatherings and one follow-up questionnaire to be completed by participants of the training sessions. The first zoom gathering will reinforce the key objectives of the initiative and frame steps for moving forward. The second zoom gathering will focus on the importance of forming collaborations with community organizations, strategies for building those relationships and recommendations for connecting services to residents. The follow up questionnaire will evaluate how much knowledge was acquired through the first training session "First Impressions Unraveling Bias.

What we learned:

- Central South District churches are committed to exploring ways to establish more equity throughout our district.
- There is an opportunity for churches serving the same geographical region to partner to extend services to residents.
- There is an existing knowledge gap between providing a service and building equity into the availability and ease of access of these services consistently to our communities.
