Since officially chartering our 501(c)(3) on February 14, 2025, The Massie Foundation has experienced tremendous growth, made possible by the dedication, generosity, and belief of our community.

We are honored to have a fully seated Board of Directors whose leadership continues to guide our mission forward. This year, The Massie Foundation was able to cover \$4,825.00 worth of services, which paid for 89 hours of mental health counseling, medication management, and substance use coaching. We are grateful to Counseling Connections Clinic for seeing clients at a reduced rate. Community partners like this help boost our mission and allow us to have a greater impact on individuals in need.

The Massie Foundation had the pleasure of participating in several impactful community events, including Family Day at MacDill Air Force Base, Kickin' Addiction, the NAMI Mental Health Summit, and the Hurricane Expo. We also partnered with Hernando Community Coalition (HCC) to host a PTSD Lunch and Learn, providing education and resources to community members on post-traumatic stress disorder.


Therapist Toolbox
