### 3. Recording Tips

- Treat it like a conversation with a friend.
- Don't worry if English isn't your first language—just give it your best shot. Authenticity matters more than perfection.
- Aim to keep the recording as short as possible, but don't over think it. Take your time; it's
  okay to pause and collect your thoughts.
- o If you have a question, start the phrase with, "My question is...". It's ok to give some background first, we may edit if it's too long though.

## 4. File Format & Quality

- Save your recording in MP3 or WAV format (WAV is best).
- If the audio quality isn't perfect but we can understand your message, don't worry—we'll
  do our best to convey your story on the podcast. In some cases, we may transcribe and
  read it out.

### 5. Submitting Your Audio

- o Attach your audio file to an email.
- o Include your name and a brief description of your message in the email body.
