

# 2025 PFLAG Newport Beach Scholarship Application

## **Scholarship Eligibility Requirements**

- 2.0 GPA, or higher.
- Must be a resident (or a parent must be a resident) of Orange County at the time of the application.
- Must identify as gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning, nonbinary, or intersex (LGBTQ+).
- Must be a high school senior continuing to higher education.

## **Scholarship Amounts**

- PFLAG Newport Beach will award one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$1,000, and three (3) mini-scholarships in the amount of \$500 each.

## **Terms and Important Dates**

- Awards will be paid directly to the student.
- The scholarship application will be made available on or before February 14, 2025.
- Application and essay must be received by PFLAG Newport Beach via email ([pflagnewportbeach@gmail.com](mailto:pflagnewportbeach@gmail.com)) by April 30, 2025.
- Decisions will be announced by May 9, 2025. Recipients will be notified by email.
- Scholarship recipients are invited to attend the Thursday, May 15, 2025, PFLAG Newport Beach meeting to accept their awards personally. Attendance at the meeting is not mandatory to receive the award.
