As an instructor Ms. Brener has taught a vast number of students of various ages, ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds. Ms. Brener's

students were accepted to the World's famous Music Schools including Manhattan School of Music, NY, Mannes College of Music, NY and Academy of Jewish Religion, Los Angeles where they pursue their Music degrees. As active solo- and chamber music performer, Irina Brener has had recitals in such renowned venues as Carnegie Hall, NY, Steinway Hall, NY, Steinway Piano Gallery, Beverly Hills, Suolahti Saal, Finland and others. After teaching at University of Redlands, CA Irina Brener has moved to Calabasas and had opened her piano studio where she is sharing her comprehensive teaching experience in Piano, Music Theory, Music History and Chamber Music.

Successful educator and promoter of Music education, Irina Brener became a member of MTAC in 2008 where her input can be measured by over 20 students annually passing CM test with highest scores and a number of students selected for performance at MTAC Annual Convention, San Jose 2015, 2017, winning local competitions and Festivals such as Contemporary Festival, Bach Festival and participating in most events held by San Fernando West Valley Branch and beyond.

As a competition judge Ms.Brener has been invited to The Gold Star Piano Competition, Los Angeles (2014), CA and the California State Judge for America's Fine Arts Festival, Los Angeles, CA (2011-2018),Conejo Valley Contemporary Festival (2016),Pleasant Valley-Ventura County Branch Competition (2018), San Fernando East Valley Classical and Romanic Festival (2019) among others.

Ms.Brener is very proud of her latest students' achievements which include prestigious performances at Carnegie Hall, New York for two consecutive years in 2017 and 2018.
