The Friends of the Union Meeting Hall (FUMH), a non-profit founded in 2019, has been working in partnership with the Town of Ferrisburgh to revitalize and restore the Union Meeting Hall. Once finished, the facility will be used to host events, Town gatherings, and exciting programs to enrich our thriving community.

PROJECT: ROOF STABILIZATION

Details: Repair/replace rotted roof trusses, install new metal snowbelt, repoint chimneys, jack-up floors, install two new piers under steeple posts, replacement of the tower and steeple roof and main roof trim repair, to include engineering drawings

Estimated Cost: \$269,000
