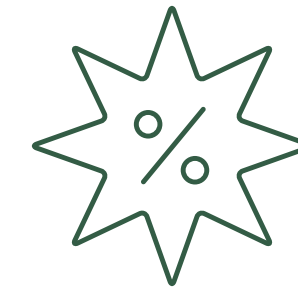
Large scale, perpetual grows,

Market size



Florida and Georgia are home to 29,000,000 with an additional 150,000,000 visitors between the 2 states.



70,000 licensed CBD retailers who need farmers.



1 in 7 Floridians use CBD or hemp on a regular.



Hemp sales are expected to hit \$5,000,000,000 in the next 5 years in Florida.

Infrastructure



Infrastructure is key. Having greenhouses and a warehouse for indoor growing will allow for year around growing and the ability to control the environment. This will also allow for products to be made on site too.



Where will sales come from?

The majority of sales and distribution for the farm will come from wholesaling the bulk raw hemp material.

Boots on the ground will be secondary, via reaching out to the 70,000 retailers with our products.
