YEAR'S **BEST** MENTORING PROGRAM STARTS THIS MONTH

Hundreds of Palatine Picklers have enjoyed our Wednesday Sycamore sessions by invitation. Students stay with three others during which they spend half an hour with each of three Mentors. Thursday afternoon and/or our Saturday afternoon walk-on sessions a Hamilton are more unpredictable. We never know how many students will show up.

Our indoor sessions at Canlan on Tuesday mornings (11/19, 12/3, & 12/17 this year) will run from 9:00 to Noon. Students will share a court with three other of similar ability all morning and will be mentored by each of six Mentors. You'd be really hard-pressed to find pickleball training that gives you more bang for your buck. After all it's free. You will have to pay Canlan's \$10 daily fee, but that's all. And when the three hours is over, we drive a mile to share a fun lunch. So if you could benefit from a little learning or a lot of review, email me at <u>aokbarry@yahoo.com</u> with the dates you expect to be available. HOWEVER, if your schedule changes, please email me by noon Saturday before your session to take you off that ETBA (Expect To Be Available) list. Failure to do so is risky. If you're selected and either don't reply to your invitation or turn it down, you earn a strike. Two strikes gets you banned from mentoring for six months. None of us want that. So I suggest putting "maybe mentoring" on your calendar each date you give me. Then you'll be reminded to email me, if you end up putting something else on that morning.

In 2024 we've mentored 101 students on Wednesday and an estimated 50-60 at Hamilton.


