## HEALTHY 2015

It was just ten months ago your Palatine Pickleball Club was formed. Since then we've done what we could to enhance your pickleball experience. In the process we have grown. We now have 238 members. Some play infrequently. A few have yet to play their first game but want to keep abreast of our activities so they'll be up to speed when they are able to step onto a court. Some play only a few months in Palatine and in other states the rest of the year. Two things we all have in common are a love of our sport and the goal of improving our play each game. 2015 was a great year for Palatine pickleball.

## HAPPY 2016

2016 should be even better. I'm pretty sure we've gotten the attention of the Palatine Park District. They now know pickleball CANNOT be lumped with shuffleboard or horseshoes ... both fine games played by a comparative handful of non-athletic elderly. Palatine Picklers may be entirtled to some old fart discounts at some restaurants, but we'd rather be running around a pickleball court at 5:00 p.m. than sharing an early bird special there. And we are far from a mere handful of enthusiasts. In 2016 I envision
gathering your signatures on a petition or two. We have some requests we feel should be addressed immediately.

1) We want screens/shades on the rest of the windows on Falcon's walking track. The glare on courts is not only annoying, it's dangerous. We have some members who smack the ball with authority. If an opponent is unable to see on the ball for half its flight, it may be impossible to avoid being hit.
2) We want some sort of glare-reduction applied to Falcon's lobby windows and doors. The east-facing team on that court, in my opinion, has about a three point advantage. That glare for those facing the lobby is far worse than any other in the gym.
3) We would like the park district to look at the number of pickleball players, commpared to volleyball or other sports, who could be served by evening play at Falcon one or more days.
4) We want the tennis courts, at least at Sycamore and Locust, lined for dual use. Often last summer players had to sit more than play, due to lack of courts. We'll have even more players in 2016. Just lining those two courts will increase our courts by $50 \%$. Yes, we'll try to assign multiple play times (days or hours for novice and others for more advanced players), but lining those courts will help considerably.
5) We want to get them thinking about a Palatine facility with at least 6 (preferably 12) courts. We're unable to host travel team play, despite having by far the largest club membershsip in the suburbs. I don't see the park districts of Hoffman Estates or Libertyville or Park Ridge or others having significantly larger populations or greater budgets, yet they have to host our travel teams.

## TRAVEL ROSTER PREP

Of course there will be residual headaches, but the biggest challenge of my pickleball year is now behind me. Below you will see the rosters for each of our upcoming 10week "travel" season ... and the partner pairings for each of the 120 games. This represents what I believe are PPC's most competitive teams, while honoring my promise to give at least one play date to every member of at least intermediate level who gave me a list of dates they'd be available to play. For our men, that meant filling 60 slots from 182 requests, not counting all those who want to play but can't commit to any date in advance ... and those kind individuals who said "Use me if/how you need me." Their kindness put them pretty much out of the running. For the ladies I had to fill 60 slots from 110 requests, not counting those available to sub.

Yeah, I like numbers. Here's another: since the November newsletter announced the revised parameters for the travel league, I have sent or received 172 e-mails on this subject. During the course of those, our teams got significantly more competitive. A number of factors contributed to the decisions I made over the five hours it took to put these rosters together. Those include perceived skill level, compatibility of playing styles, complementary playing styles when compatible wasn't there, compatible personalities, and an attempt at practical equity. Seeding each of our 12 teams for each date involved even more considerations. There was a lot of subjectivity, and individual evaluations took a back seat to team evaluations. And moving some players around the seedings so they don't keep playing the same opponents also was considered.

Do I expect everyone to be happy with my decisions? Of course not. Even I'm not happy about them. I'd hoped to make all ten rosters, but I'm on only three.

Will I listen to your complaints, self-evaluations, and suggestions. Absolutely. Just put them in the second paragraph of an e-mail to me. Your first paragraph should read, "I want to serve on the PPC Board in 2016." After making my day with your first paragraph, I'll be open-minded to all you say in your second.

## SUBS

Four of PPC's top, men players (Ralph Cook, Steve Erdman, Jim Roland, and Tim Saunders) have schedules that are not set well in advance but should, with short notice, have several available play dates. In my opiniion, these four have climbed higher on the skills ladder than the rest of us. Since we'll be facing strong competition each week, it would be great to have them represent PPC as much as possible. I hope to fill the ten SUB positions you see on the schedule above with them. I'm fronting the $\$ 63$ for these open slots and will collect from them, when they commit to a date.

On the chart below you'll find plenty of fine players who will be happy to sub on the dates shown. I really appreciate that several said they'd be available on dates indicated but were fine not being on any roster.

If you find yourself unable to play on any of your designated dates, it is up to you to find a sub. Call or text me (224-595-2697) or e-mail me as soon as you know you won't be able to play. Please identify yourself, as I may not recognize your phone number or e-mail address. I'll then e-mail you a list of all our subs of your gender with their phone numbers. Check their availability on the chart and start calling. When you find one, LET ME KNOW. I'll need to adjust the roster, possibly change partner pairings, and get the new roster to that week's "Captain" to turn in the morning of the match. (I'll appoint a willing Captain for each match date.) Yes, it would be easier for all of us, if I simply printed the entire list of subs and numbers here, but I prefer to protect their privacy.
