LOWER INTERMEDIATE PALATINE PICKLERS vs BARRINGTONIANS

This fall we're changing the format for these every other Tuesday matches. In the past each town has fielded a team of four men and four ladies. Captains assigned partners for both gender and mixed games. Because Barrington's captain, Jim Simmons, has a shortage of ladies, we're changing to unisex teams of eight players. Each player will play one game with each of his/her seven teammatesMatches are held at the Canlan Sportsplex in Lake Barrington. Play begins at 9:00. Canlan charges \$7 per day.

This league is for players from 2.5 up to the 3.5 level. (If in doubt as to your level, someone who can give you an idea of yours.) Let me stress that we will field teams of different players each match. You are not signing up for the whole season. 



This was a popular tournament. When all was done, Kenny Thakker emerged the King. Marv Zwass took 2nd and Linda Gariano captured 3rd.


