## **BREAK FOR NEWS ... CLUB RATINGS PROGRESS**

Greg collects these cards and sends the info on to be analyzed by the "Green Machine," a pickleball ratings program. Every week or two our club members' ratings will be updated. These can be accessed via our website **PalatinePicklers.com**. It's still early, but, with a few early exceptions, it's already showing itself to be pretty accurate, at least in terms of a pecking order. See what you think. In my opinion it may compress things toward the middle, lowering the ratings of our top players and raising the ratings of our weaker ones. Let's see how it plays out, once everyone has 50+ games recorded.

### A LOOK FORWARD TO FALL AT FALCON

Our Falcon season starts Monday, September 18<sup>th</sup>. The fee for the Monday and Friday 8:00-Noon play is either \$6 per day or a 10-play pass for \$50. These sessions are for those who are at least 50. Wednesdays from 8:00-Noon are for those at least 18, and the fee is either \$4 per day or a 10-play pass for \$30 which can be used Wednesdays at Falcon AND Thursdays at Birchwood. (See below)




## DANA & CHUCK'S OUTDOOR, WHEELING TOURNAMENT
