## CHICAO METRO PICKLEBALL ... NEXT SESSION

We're within a month of being done with the first season of the CMP league. Our competitions for four Clubs (Team April, Team Dana, Team Ken, \& Team Bear) takes place every other Tuesday afternoon in Libertyville. It's for players in the 3.75 to 4.25 range. Each Captain sends four men and four women seeded 1 to 4 into battle. Each player plays with one gender partner and one mixed partner, facing each of the other teams once. That means six games are played by each partiipant. Team wins matter. Total points will break ties. The playoffs for our first session are on April $9^{\text {th }}$.

At this writing the next session has yet to be determined. Will we remain inside? Will we begin moving each match around the suburbs? Will we have a mini season at Libertyville? I don't know. Those decisions are pending. However, if you feel you are in the designated skill range and would like to compete, please email me at aokbarry@yahoo.com. Teams have twice the number of players needed any week. All team members will get to play, but the play time may not be equally distributed. Captains create their own rosters for each match. The one thing on which all participants, win or lose, agree is this is a really fun league.

I should add that letting me know you want "in" doesn't guarantee you'll be on my team. The Captains shuffle players, in an effort to make each team have similar talent. Of course, there's a limit to the number of players the league can accept. The first 32 women and 32 men to "apply" get into the next session.


## NOT TOO EARLY TO PLAN FOR SR GAMES

Some tournaments are round robin format. You don't need a partner. The Six County Senior Games is not one of those. That means it's time to begin thinking of your gender partner and/or your mixed partner. All games will be played at Fabbrini Park in Hoffman Estaes. Women's doubles will be held on Tuesday. July $9^{\text {th }}$. Men's doubles will be Thursday, July $11^{\text {th }}$. Mixed doubles will be contested Saturday, July $13^{\text {th }}$. At this point I do not know about singles. The divisions are all by 5 -year age increments, with no consideration of level so you'll want partner/s about your age. For those who have competed in the past, you should get this year's prospectus in May. The rest of you can Google "2019 Six County Senior Games," in a couple months, to get registration information.
