## STILL TIME TO GET INTO OUR BIONIC TOURNAMENT

At 9:30 next Tuesday morning (December 10 th), Picklers with a new hip, knee, or shoulder will take to the Canlan courts in Lake Barrington. As I write this, twelve, "bionic" Picklers are planning on playing. I'll close registration at 6:00 p.m. on Friday the $6^{\text {th }}$. That will give me three days to create a format and make a scoreboard. There are no age, skill, or gender restrictions for this fun event. After we take photos at the end of competition, those whose schedule allows will head to the Onion Pub for lunch, just 200 yards south on Pepper Road.

On the evening of Friday the $6^{\text {th }}$, all participants will be asked to confirm their intent to play. I usually ask for such confirmation one or two days before an event, but this tournament requires more preparation time than most.

REM INDER ... Change sides half way through your time on the glare court at Falcon. Round up. If you migrate there at $6-3$, that leaves 5 points to 11 . Round 2.5 up to 3 , and change sides when one pair reaches 9 .


## LIVE ON, IN THE BIRTHPLACE OF PICKLEBALL

You've read about this opportunity in previous newsletters. On Bainbridge Island, Washington more than half a century ago, pickleball was invented. The game grew ... you can find out how by clicking on this link M arilyn Darby shared: HIstory of Pickleball

The original court still exists. Six other courts have been built, and they'll be joined by $\$ 230,000$ of six, new courts, a park-like entrance showing the sport's history, and a brick walkway surrounding the area. Two sies of bricks can be purchased and engraved. A $12 \times 12$ brick with our logo and 8 lines of 15 characters \& spaces goes for $\$ 56.25$ per line. We have one such brick sold out. We'll need all eight lines purchased, if we're to have a second, large brick. Then there is an $8 \times 8$ brick which has PALATINE PICKLERS at the top and five lines of up to 20 characters \& spaces. So far our first such brick has four lines sold. These lines are only \$30 each.
