#### 2<sup>nd</sup> TRY ... THIS SHOULD WORK

For many years the Palatine Picklers fielded a 3.0 to 3.5 team of four men and four women to play against another team. Originally, it was against Midtown one week and against Barrington the next. Great fun for a while. Then both opponents exceeded the skill range, and it became less fun. I set it up for the two of them to play each other on another day, while each would give two men and two women of appropriate level to play as MidBar against our team. That worked really well for a while. I had at least 20 men and 20 women wanting to be on those teams. Then neither Midtown nor Barrington could come up with two men and two women so I had to fill in their teams with Palatine Picklers. Not as much fun. Then came COVID. Nothing. Last fall I tried to start this up again but with just a single opponent. Barrington couldn't come up with four men and four women. Neither could Midtown. Libertyville couldn't either. I tried Hoffman. They thought they'd have the numbers but didn't like Canlan's lack of a mask mandate, as there would be unmasked players in the gym. That seemed the end of competitions at this level.

Last month I had inspiration. Let's have intramural competitions. Let's have four men and four women aged 65 and under play against four men and four women 65+ (OK, I proposed 60+, but it became obvious that older Picklers were more interested so...) every other Tuesday morning. We'll have two, competitive teams. But, like most everything else I've tried since February, 2020, only a fraction of the pre-COVID response was received. So this is the 2<sup>nd</sup> and final try to get a really fun, bi-weekly competition going. Maybe the idea of needing Captains was too intimidating. To get this going, I'll bite the bullet and make both rosters for each match, if no one wants to Captain their team. Just sign up, if you're in that 3.0 - 3.5 level. This is really fun. And, when the pandemic subsides, we'll all go out to lunch after the matches. That's really fun too.


## **QUALITY OVER QUANITITY OF MEDALISTS**




