INTRAMURALS AND MENTORING FOR REST OF 2023

INTRAMURALS ... Our ongoing intramural program is for intermediate (3.0-3.5) Picklers. It's every other week. No long-term commitment. I roster different Picklers each match. I try to balance the play dates for all interested players. I select 8 men and 8 ladies. Then I arrange them in order of their age. The youngest 4 men and 4 ladies will represent the Whippersnappers, while the older 4 and 4 will play for the Wise Ones. These are round robin events. You will play one game partnering with each of your 7 teammates. The team with the most wins is victorious that day. In case of a tie, the total points scored determines the winner. The teams have been very competitive. That means our winning days are almost equal. It doesn't mean that this is serious competition. It's all for fun.

After the match which runs from 9:00 to about 11:45 a.m. in the Canlan Sportsplex in Lake Barrington, those whose schedule allows enjoy lunch a mile away. Our Summer Mentoree Tourament will be held in Canlan Sportsplex on Tuesday morning, November 7th, starting at 8:45. 


NOW THIS IS A BIRTHDAY CAKE

Playing pickleball really can be an out of this world experience. Here you see enthusiasts playing at 35,000 feet.




TIPS FOR PREVENTING PICKLEBALL INJURIES
