A Life Thought in the Church Year for September 8 – Pentecost XVI

(Proper 18B): Almighty God makes the Prophet Isaiah solemnly proclaim, “Behold, your God will come ... He will come and save” (Isaiah 35:4). Jesus demonstrates its fulfillment when He does not cast aside but cares for the burdened body of a neighbor with impairments (Mark 7:32-35).
