Look up the definitions to words you don't know and do a mini study session on the verse you're trying to figure out. Ask God to explain it to you, He is the one who wrote it after all. In order to stand firm in your faith, you must know why you believe in the things you do, which comes from studying to show yourselves approved (2 Timothy 2:15) 'Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth'. ~ **I am a New Creation** (2 Corinthians 5:17) 'Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come'

~ **I am a temple of the Holy Spirit, I belong to God** (1 Corinthians 6:19) 'Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own...'

~ **I am free and no longer bound to things holding me back** (Galatians 5:1) 'For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery'

~ **I am a friend of God and know His plans for me** (John 15:15) 'No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you'

~ **I am faithful** (Hebrews 10:23) 'Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful'

~ **I am unstoppable** (Philippians 4:13) 'I can do all things through him who strengthens me'

~ **I am created with a purpose** (Ephesians 2:10) 'For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them'

~ **I am righteous in Christ** (2 Corinthians 5:21) 'For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God'

~ **I am a living sacrifice, Holy and acceptable to God** (Romans 12:1) 'I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship'

~ **I am not condemned in Christ** (Romans 8:1) 'There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus'

~ **I am a chosen one, Holy and beloved with the fruits of the Spirit** (Colossians 3:12) ‘Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience...’

~ **I am raised in Christ** (Colossians 3:1) ‘If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God’

~ **I am supported** (Philippians 4:19) ‘And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus’

~ **I am full of wonderful thoughts** (Philippians 4:8) ‘Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things’

~ **I have the mind of Christ** (1 Corinthians 2:16) ““For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?” But we have the mind of Christ’

~ **I am unified** (1 Corinthians 1:2) ‘To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours...’

~ **I am a giver** (Luke 6:38) ‘Give, and it will be given to you. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For with the measure you use it will be measured back to you.”’

~ **I am constantly denying myself to follow Jesus** (Matthew 16:24) ‘Then Jesus told his disciples, “If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me”.


~ **I am set up for welfare, a future and hope** (Jeremiah 29:11) ‘For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope’

~ **I am full of action and truth** (1 John 3:18) ‘Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth’

~ **I am no longer making a practice of sin** (1 John 3:8) ‘Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil’

~ **I am sober-minded and watchful** (1 Peter 5:8) ‘Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour’

~ **I am to suffer in Glory** (1 Peter 4:16) ‘Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in that



- ~ **I am an honoring believer by knowing why I believe in Christ** (1 Peter 3:15) 'But in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect...'
- ~ **I am called to handle hard things** (1 Peter 2:21) 'For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps'
- ~ **I am God's people in mercy** (1 Peter 2:10) 'Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy'
- ~ **I am obedient and Holy** (1 Peter 1:14-15) 'As obedient children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, but as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct...'
- ~ **I am submissive** (James 4:7) 'Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you'
- ~ **I am confident to go to my Father for grace** (Hebrews 4:16) 'Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need'
- ~ **I am ready for every good work** (Titus 3:1) 'Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work...'
- ~ **I am not fearful** (2 Timothy 1:7) 'For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control'
- ~ **I am an overseer** (1 Timothy 3:2) 'Therefore an overseer must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach...'
- ~ **I am no longer 'earthly'** (Colossians 3:5) 'Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry'
- ~ **I am thinking of things above** (Colossians 3:2) 'Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth'
- ~ **I am prayerful** (Colossians 1:9) 'And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding...'
- ~ **I am full of grace and peace** (Colossians 1:2) 'To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ at Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father'
- ~ **I am headed towards life, not death** (Philippians 3:19) 'Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things'

~ **I confess that Jesus Christ is Lord** (Philippians 2:11) ‘And every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father’

~ **I am continuously seeking the mysteries of Christ** (Ephesians 5:32) ‘This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church’

~ **I am a member of God’s church** (Ephesians 5:30) ‘Because we are members of his body’

~ **I am sacrificial to my wife** (Ephesians 5:25) ‘Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her...’

~ **I am an imitator of God** (Ephesians 5:1) ‘Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children’

~ **I am graceful in speech** (Ephesians 4:29) ‘Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear”

~ **I am renewed** (Ephesians 4:23) ‘And to be renewed in the spirit of your minds...’

~ **I am a favored** (Ephesians 3:20) ‘Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us...’

~ **I am seated with Jesus** (Ephesians 2:6) ‘And raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus...’

~ **I am the body of Christ** (Ephesians 1:22-23) ‘And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all’

~ **I am redeemed** (Ephesians 1:7) ‘In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace...’

~ **I am Holy and blameless** (Ephesians 1:4) ‘Even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love...’

~ **I am blessed** (Ephesians 1:3) ‘Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places...’

~ **I am not tired of doing what’s good** (6:9-10) ‘And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith’

~ **I am full of the fruits of the Spirit** (Galatians 5:22-23) ‘But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law’

~ **I am in freedom** (Galatians 5:13) ‘For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another’

~ **I am a son and heir to God** (Galatians 4:7) ‘So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son,  
• then an heir through God’

~ **I am one in Christ** (Galatians 3:28) ‘There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

~ **I am living for God** (Galatians 2:20) ‘I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me’

~ **I am being transformed** (2 Corinthians 3:18) ‘And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit’

~ **I am unveiled** (2 Corinthians 3:14) ‘But their minds were hardened. For to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains unlifted, because only through Christ is it taken away’

~ **I am led and full of knowledge** (2 Corinthians 2:14) ‘But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere’

~ **I am around good people** (1 Corinthians 15:33) ‘Do not be deceived: “Bad company ruins good morals”’

~ **I am one with God** (1 Corinthians 6:16-17) ‘Or do you not know that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For, as it is written, “The two will become one flesh.” But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him’

~ **I am welcoming** (Romans 15:7) ‘Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God’

~ **I am living in peace** (Romans 12:18) ‘If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all’

~ **I am hospitable** (Romans 12:18) ‘Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality’

~ **I am in faith** (Romans 10:17) ‘So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ’

~ **I am destined** (Romans 8:29) ‘For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers’

~ **I am trustful** (Romans 8:28) 'And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose'

~ **I am a child of God** (Romans 8:17) 'And if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him'

~ **I am fearless** (Romans 8:15) 'For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"'

~ **I am led by God** (Romans 8:14) 'For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God'

~ **I am who God says I am**

### Life and Death are in the Power of the Tongue

'Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits' (Proverbs 18:21).

Only we have to ability to change our lives and go in a direction that we'll look back on a year from now and either be proud or embarrassed on what we've done with the time given. We will be held accountable by God on what we've done with our lives. We're called to lift ourselves up to His standard while choosing Him as a guide. We follow His people that are 'ahead' of us while also leading those 'behind' us. It makes no sense to expect a better treatment from anyone when you're unwilling to do it yourself. The only person that came to save you is Jesus, it's up to you to actually do the work given to you. This work happens on the inside out. The reason most people don't know where they're going is because they haven't spent enough time with themselves to know who they are as a person. Everyone is damaged to a degree, hurt and traumatized... it's up to you to rewire yourself (which is very possible) so that you can be who God created you to be.

It's a 'Be, Do, Have' type of system in which God multiplies. You will have to own up to your mistakes while overcoming past actions. It's your responsibility to choose better for yourself and those around you, which is hard. Work on yourself, examine where you are in each area of your life (using the Godly Elements) and go from there. See where you can improve in each dimension and work at that every day. The hardest part is believing in yourself, which is why you need God. Shift your focus on who He says you are and run with that. Spend time with Him alone in the Word, your prayer closet and around other believers. You got this!
