Information in Relation to Burial Options

To accompany this handout, I've included a range of brochures on grief and bereavement specific to your situation. These are intended to help you, and others, over the coming weeks and months to get assistance from professionals to help you process your grief, talk about your situation and be able to move forward.

The information below is intended to help you make some decisions in the near future about the choices you have for your loved one. Your Funeral Director will be able to provide further specific information and help you to make decisions for your loved one.

Burial Options (Internment)

Options for burial are various and include the option to bury your loved one in a coffin/casket or to be buried as cremated remains.

A lawn burial can accommodate up to 3 burials, though they must all belong to the same family. See attached brochure for fees and options for monuments.

When opting for burial there are various options for consideration such as location, monuments, and grave lining.

Entombment

This is internment in a mausoleum and is subject to availability, see attached brochure for fees.

Cremation

Cremation options are for the same day, or within a few days if there's no strict timeline. The more expedient the requirement the more costly the fee. The fees also vary depending on the age of the person being cremated.

Cremated Remains

Cremated remains can be provided in one container or urn or dispersed into many depending on familial requirements and options for burial/dispersal.

Dispersal & Placement Options

Cremated remains can be buried on site by opting for one of the various burial methods outlined in the Geelong Cemeteries Trust brochure. Alternately you can take cremated remains with you to be dispersed as you wish.

There are a range of other fees also listed in the brochure attached (Annex A – Geelong Cemeteries Trust) covering all varieties of situations including permits and fees, monuments, and headstones. Please ensure to consult with your Funeral Director so you can make an informed decision about the options and prices for your loved one's memorial and placement. The brochure also advises on catering options for their function room, orders of service and memorial urns.
