

Sample Schedule with Embedded High Leverage Initial Precursor Linkage Level Skills

Below is a sample daily schedule with examples of how “high leverage” Initial Precursor Linkage Level Skills can be embedded.

Time	Activity	Embedded Linkage Level Skill(s)
8:30–9:00 AM	Morning Routine & Calendar	- Attend to familiar people/routines - Demonstrate understanding of object names
9:00–9:30 AM	Whole Group Reading Activity	- Identify pictures that go with a familiar text - Identify a concrete detail using AAC or gestures
9:30–10:00 AM	Centers / Small Group Rotation	- Draw conclusions based on category knowledge - Arrange objects in pairs
10:00–10:30 AM	Snack / Social Skills	- Demonstrate understanding of property words - Recognize separateness
10:30–11:00 AM	Math Lesson / Hands-On Activities	- Order objects - Combine and partition sets
11:00–11:30 AM	Functional Science or Social Studies	- Pay attention to object characteristics due to language cues - Recognize same
11:30–12:30 PM	Lunch / Recess	- Classify - Identify familiar people, objects, places, and events
12:30–1:00 PM	Communication Activities / AAC Practice	Identify words that describe familiar persons, places, things, or events
1:00–1:30 PM	Life Skills Instruction	Recognize sets and subsets
1:30–2:00 PM	Review & Reflection	Identify familiar people, objects, places, and events
2:00–2:30 PM	Dismissal Routine	Pay attention to object characteristics due to language cues
