#### RULES FOR THE LANDING

If the Landing is to remain a family friendly condominium, the owners must enforce the rules. If someone is violating a rule, they probably are unaware they are causing a problem for their neighbors. Please, have a civil adult conversation with the offender so we all can have fun and enjoy our time at the Landing.

#### **General Rules:**

- 1. **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUESTS.** Please make sure they know the rules.
- 2. Quiet time is from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.
- 3. Observe all posted signs, especially 10 MPH speed limit. Children are playing.
- 4. Only **EMPTY** boat and PWC trailers are allowed to be parked on the parking area hard top. A trailer with a PWC or a boat on the hard top will block someone's view of the lake.
- 5. Park all vehicles behind buildings. Do not leave your vehicle on the hard top.
- 6. Keep dogs on a leash and scoop poop.
- 7. No RV's, buses or large trucks can be parked on the Landing's property (inside the chain link fence).
- 8. ONLY GAS GRILLS ARE PERMITTED ON OR NEAR CONDO DECKS AND PORCHES AND ONLY IF A FIRE EXTINGUISHER IS PHYSICALLY PRESENT BESIDE THE GRILL (New Insurance Requirement).
- 9. No fireworks are allowed at the Landing.

# **Pool Rules:**

- 1. The pool is to be locked at all times. The Owners will be given the current entry code.
- 2. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 3. Parents are responsible for their children.
- 4. Follow the posted rules, especially:
  - a. No Glass or Pets inside the pool fence.
  - b. No Diving or Running in the pool area.
- 5. Please do not leave trash or personal belongings in the pool area.
- 6. If you are coming directly out of the lake, be sure to wash off before entering the pool. This will help keep the pool clean and free of bacteria.

## **Dock Rules:**

- 1. The dock and ramp facilities are for Owners and Guests only.
- 2. Jet skis are not permitted in boat slips.
- 3. Boaters and Jet skiers should approach dock at idle speed.
  - a. There is a no wake zone (idle speed only) within 100 feet of the dock. This is a BRA requirement.
  - b. Please watch for swimmers especially around the swimming platform area and give them the right of way.
- 4. If severe weather is forecast, your boat should be pulled from the water.
  - a. If your boat damages the dock, you may be assessed for the cost of repairs.
- 5. No cleaning fish on the dock. Clean fish in your condo and put the guts in a sealed plastic bag in the trash.

#### **Maintenance Rules:**

- 1. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR SMOKE ALARMS IN YOUR UNIT(S). Our insurance requires that each unit has a working smoke detector. New batteries will be distributed each year at the Owners' Meeting.
- 2. USE ONLY SEPTIC SAFE TOILET TISSUE. Septic safe toilet paper is labeled "septic safe" on the toilet paper packaging.
- 3. <u>DON'T FLUSH ANYTHING THAT MIGHT PLUG THE SEPTIC SYSTEM OR KILL BACTERIA</u>--hair combings, paper towels, wet wipes, dental floss, kitty litter, cigarette butts, chemicals, prescription drugs, antibacterial soap, sanitary napkins, tampons, bandages, paint, fat, grease, oil, etc.
- 4. REDUCE DISPOSE-ALL USE by putting table scraps, coffee grounds, apple cores, peelings, etc. in a sealed plastic bag in the trash.

# **Close-up Rules:**

- 1. Turn the water off to the Hot Water Heater at the valve located on top of the unit.
- 2. Turn the water off to each commode.
- 3. Turn the water off to the clothes washer.
- 4. LAST ONE TO LEAVE A GROUP OF CONDOS SERVED BY A SINGLE WATER MAIN MUST TURN THE MAIN VALVE OFF.
- 5. Set the thermostat to a minimum of 55 degrees in the winter.
- 6. Ensure all electrical appliances are turned off and/or unplugged: stove, oven, counter appliances, curling irons, fans, etc.
- 7. Empty all trash and place outside in secured trash bins and/or dumpsters.
