

2024 NCBW Seattle Scholarship Announcement

<u>Purpose</u>

Chartered in September 2021, the National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Inc. (NCBW) Greater Seattle Chapter serves to advocate on behalf of Black women and girls to promote leadership development and gender equity in the areas of health, education, and economic empowerment. As a newly chartered chapter, we are committed to being a united voice and helping elevate the quality of life for young Black Women and other Black women in the Pacific Northwest.

The NCBW Greater Seattle Chapter is pleased to offer students from high schools in the greater Seattle area (this includes King, Kitsap, Pierce, Snohomish, Thurston counties) an opportunity to apply for a Scholarship to aid in funding their personal investment in higher education. This merit based scholarship is for high school seniors who meet the academic requirements and have demonstrated financial aid need.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for this scholarship:

- > Be a Black woman
- > Be a high school senior graduating within the 2023-2024 school year from a high school in one of the following counties: King, Kitsap, Pierce, Snohomish, Thurston
- > Have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale at the time of application
- Have been accepted into an accredited institution of higher learning: a two to four-year college or university or a technical/vocational school at the time of application. Proof of acceptance must be submitted with the scholarship application.
- > Proof of enrollment is required if selected for the scholarship award.

Selection Criteria

The Scholarship Committee will take into consideration the following when selecting scholarship recipients:

- > Completeness of application packet (incomplete applications will not be considered)
- A minimum of 40 hours of extracurricular activities and/or community involvement (school or community organizations, volunteer activity, work experiences, family caregiving responsibilities)
- > Strength of personal statement



- Demonstration of financial need through completed FAFSA or other documentation -Academic achievement
- > Two Letters of recommendation:
 - o One letter must be written by school personnel
 - o One from a member of the community that is not a family member

Scholarship Awards

Awards in the amount of \$500.00 will be announced on June 3, 2024 and **dispersed upon** verification of college/university enrollment for the Fall 2024 term.

Application Packet

Applicants must submit their completed packet to the NCBW Greater Seattle scholarship committee by **May 15, 2024**. The following must be included in the application packet:

- > Scholarship Applicant Form
- > Applicant Activity Sheet
- > Official, sealed transcript of grades
- > Two sealed letters or recommendation
 - o One letter must be written by school personnel
 - o One from a member of the community that is not a family member
 - Recommenders should email their letters directly to the NCBW email address or P.O. Box
- > Copy of completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or other approved documentation demonstrating financial need
- > A personal statement that is 250 typed words or less.

Personal Statement

Scholarship Details: This need-based scholarship is an endeavor to provide encouragement and financial assistance to Black women who wish to further their education and by doing so plan to advocate on behalf of Black women and girls the areas of health, education, and economic empowerment.



Personal Statement (250 typed words or less): NCBW-Greater Seattle aims to improve the lives of Black women and girls and with the focus on health, education, and economic empowerment. What impact could you have in these areas by furthering your education?
