SERVICES:

OPEN STUDY HALL! Every Wednesday students may ride the bus to Bend Gate Elementary School & walk over to Chapel Hill Church. Even if you don't have homework & just need a way to get here. Just have a parent/guardian let Youth Pastor Christa know you are coming!

HILLTOP MDL is our mid-week program where middle schoolers (grades 6-8) meet **Wednesdays** from 5:30-7:30 PM, at the Chapel Hill Chruch. Before the program begins students can enjoy a free meal, play pool, table tennis, video games, and just hang out with each other and our staff. Once the program begins, we seek to engage them through energetic games, Biblical and age-appropriate teaching, and thoughtful small group discussions.

BIBLE STUDY is **Sunday mornings** from 8:30-9:30AM (all year round). Students (grades 6-12) are able to meet in order to deepen their faith and understanding of scripture. Breakfast snacks are provided.

SERVICE is **Sunday mornings** from 10:00AM-11:00AM. Students gather together in corporate worship with all ages. Students are able to serve as acolytes by bringing the light of Jesus into the service and lighting the candles and taking the light out at the end of service. Students sit in front of the praise team.

Fundraisers

Next year students will be going to Summer Camp (June 15-June 19, 2026) at Jonathan Camp Crossings. As such, students will need to fundraise to help pay for their spots! When students are physically present at fundraisers, the funds will be divided between the students working to assist in offsetting the cost for families. Those who are not present will not receive any funding from the Church. Due to increase in prices the Church and Youth Ministry cannot fully fund all students.
