

# HELLIANS PRIVATE GOLDEN CIRCLE TOUR


## Suggested Itinerary

September 6th



 **10:30 Pick up - Reykjavik**

Pick you up from the Cruise Port at 10:30 AM.



 **11:30 - 12:30 Þingvellir National Park**

Þingvellir National Park (Thingvellir) is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Iceland's most historic and scenic locations. Set in a dramatic rift valley where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates meet, it offers incredible views and unique geology. Our visit typically begins at the Visitor Centre viewpoint overlooking the Þingvellir plains, followed by a walk down the Almannagjá fissure. We'll also view Peningagjá—known for its crystal-clear water—with the charming Þingvellir church nearby. If time and conditions allow, we may also stop at Öxarárfoss waterfall.

### **13:30 - 15:00 Geysir Geothermal Area (and LUNCH time)**

Geysir Geothermal Park, located in the Haukadalur Valley, is home to bubbling hot springs, steaming vents, and erupting geysers. The most famous, Strokkur, erupts every 5 to 10 minutes, shooting boiling water up to 30 meters high. Although the Great Geysir, which gave all geysers their name, is mostly dormant, the area's geothermal activity remains a stunning natural spectacle. Visitors can explore vibrant mineral deposits and feel the Earth's intense heat beneath their feet.

### **15:15 - 16:00 Gullfoss Waterfall**



Gullfoss, or the "Golden Falls," is one of Iceland's most iconic waterfalls, located on the Hvítá River. It cascades in two dramatic tiers, plunging a total of 32 meters into a rugged canyon. On sunny days, mist from the falls creates stunning rainbows, adding to its breathtaking beauty. Gullfoss is a key stop on the Golden Circle and is known for its raw power and scenic surroundings.

🕒 **16:50 - 17:20 Kerið Crater**

Kerið is a vibrant volcanic crater formed about 3,000 years ago. Its striking red rock walls surround a deep blue lake, creating a breathtaking natural contrast. Visitors can walk around the rim or down to the water, making it an easy and popular spot to experience Iceland's volcanic landscape up close.
