

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

The best way to understand **The Loop** is to be there to experience its history. Get some exercise, while keeping a safe distance from others as you learn about what people experienced here in the 1870's. Anyone can get the **FREE APP** by clicking on the "**Do The Loop**" image. That will enable you to "**Do The Loop**". You will need to set your mobile device for picking up a data signal and enable the GPS location service. It would be a good idea to set your display for at least 15 minutes before it automatically turns off between locations. **The Browser Based APP** knows your location and whenever it enters a different, invisible "**Geo-Fence**" on the trail, your device responds with historical graphics, text narratives and **AUDIO** information about the same location as it was many years ago. You can start your tour anywhere on the trail. Always look at the map to see where you are, and where the next interesting location can be found.
