Update from Lawns & Grounds Director: Annette Glary

September was a busy month for Lawn and Grounds. We discovered army worms in some of our neighbors' lawns, and we added that (unbudgeted) treatment. It was very effective, and we are seeing new growth coming back in some of the hardest hit lawns.

As you may have noticed, the city of Overland Park ash tree removal program has come to Heatherwood. Both of our Heatherwood entrances were hit the hardest. Overnight, our shade gardens were introduced to direct sun. We will be working on the gardens to help transition to sun-friendly plants. Tree replacement will be the responsibility of Overland Park, and we've been informed this is part of a two-year plan.

It does seem as if summer is not leaving quietly. With these high temperatures and sunny days, please continue to water your lawns. We are starting to see some brown and dry lawns in the neighborhood. Watering will help with those areas from disease damage and continue to build strong roots. Thanks for keeping us green.
