Fixing Knitting Mistakes

Have you ever had an 'oops' moment while knitting and discovered that you have made a mistake?

Then this class is for you.

We will cover the most frequently made mistakes in knitting and will demonstrate how to correct them.

This class is for both beginners and advanced knitters who want a refresher.

Supplies Needed for Class:

- Crochet Hook – Size F or G
- Small Scissors
- Split Ring or Locking Stitch Markers
- Tapestry Needle
- Small Double-Point Needles
- Cable Needle

Homework

Pre-Knitted sample (on needles):

Using a light color DK or Worsted weight yarn, create a 6x6 inch swatch using a 6 or 8 needle depending on your yarn type. Half the stitches should be knitted in stockinette and the other half of the stitches are knitted in garter stitch.

Cast on an even number of stitches that will give you a six (6) inch width.

The first three (3) rows will provide a garter edge.

Row 1 - Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit 2 at the beginning and Knit 2 at the end of the row

Center stitches: Knit half of your stitches, Purl half of your stitches.

Row 5: Knit 2, Purl Center Stitches, Knit 2

Repeat rows 4 and 5 until you have 5 ½ inches (ending with row 5).

Leave your swatch on your needle.
