<p><b>Driver</b></p> <p>(For dates and times at each city - click on links above)</p>	<p>Start at the staging location at scheduled time. Participate in a short training. Get matched with a canvasser who needs a driver. Drive canvasser to doors. A map and names/addresses of voters will be provided. Forge the best driving path to doors, and support your canvasser.</p> <p>Return to office for snacks 😊</p>

## Voters Need to Know

### Election Day: November 5th!

- 1) Make a plan to vote! Early in-person voting starts Tuesday, October 22. In Wisconsin you may register and vote on the same day - even on election day November 5th, as long as you have the appropriate documentation. To check your registration, find your polling place, and/or to see your ballot in advance, go to <https://myvote.wi.gov>
- 2) Please **VOTE NO** on the constitutional amendment this November. This is the fifth confusing constitutional amendment on the ballot this year alone, and would erect barriers for voters who are likely already facing challenges in voting.

It is already illegal for non-US citizens to vote.

This amendment opens the door to discriminatory practices against voters of color, non-English-speaking individuals and those who speak English as a second language. Send a message to Republicans to STOP with confusing constitutional amendments...**VOTE NO!**
