It has been a remarkable couple of weeks since our last newsletter. We are living in unprecedented times, with history being made nearly every day.

On July 13th, former President Donald Trump survived an assassination attempt while campaigning in Pennsylvania. Just days later the Republican National Convention was held in Milwaukee. Attendees cheered mass deportation and anointed a convicted felon-who-would-be-king as their leader. Then President Joe Biden withdrew from the 2024 presidential race, and endorsed Vice President Kamala Harris. Less than 48 hours later, Vice President Harris announced that she had earned the support of enough delegates to secure the Democratic nomination for President.

Her first campaign stop was Milwaukee - and Brienne was there.

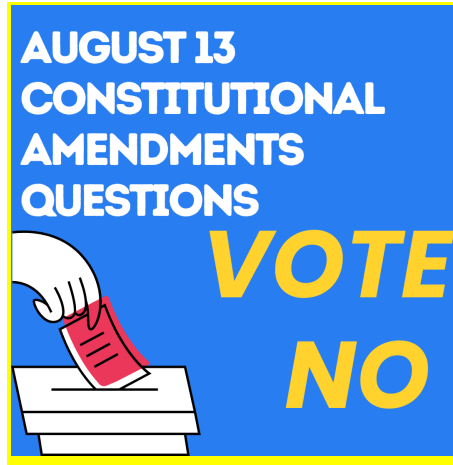

August 13 - 2024 Partisan Primary Election

October 16 - Last day to register by mail or online for the general election

November 5 - General Election
