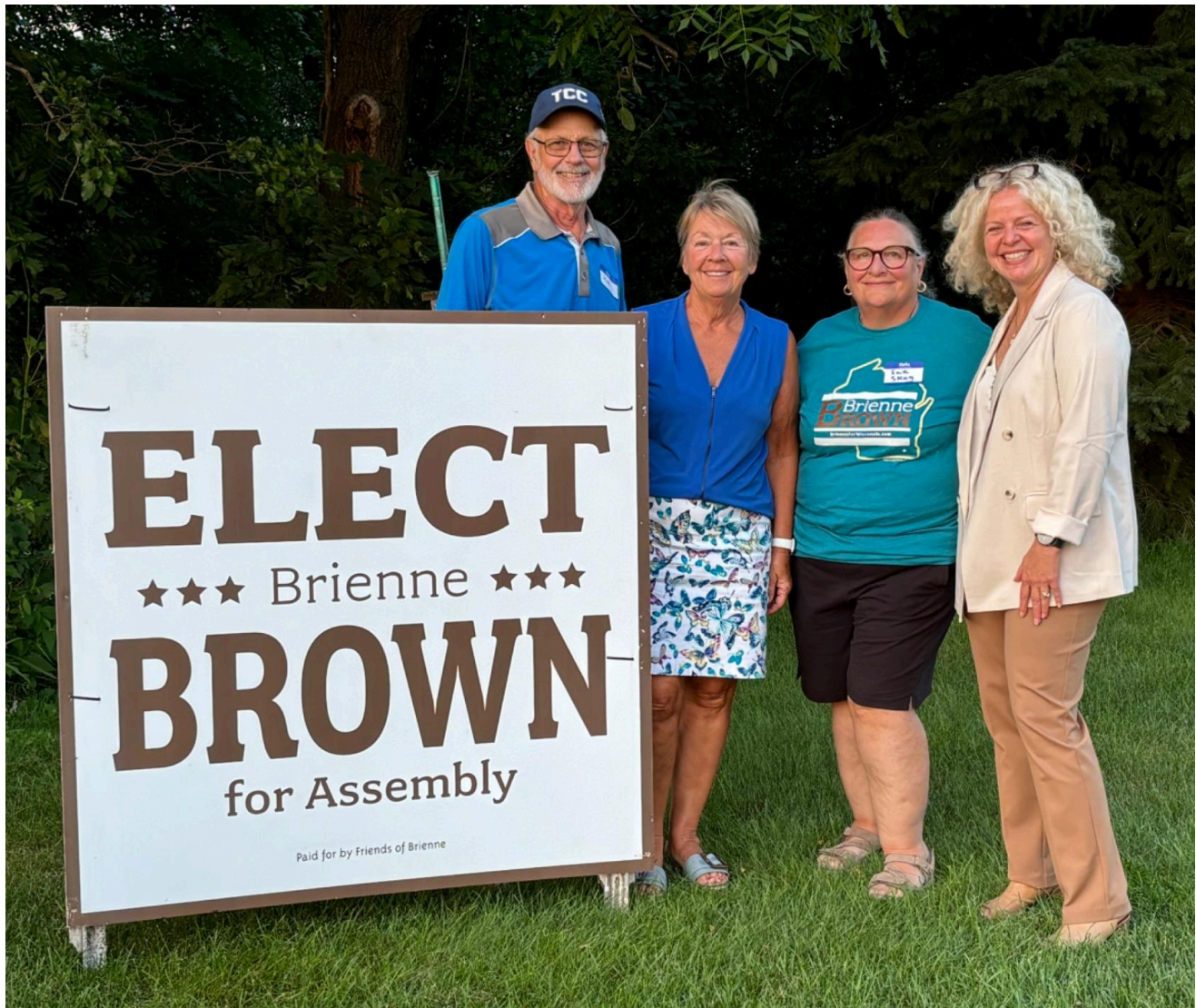

The Wisconsin Primary election is today, Tuesday, August 13. Brienne does not have a primary opponent, but there are two Republicans battling it out – Dylan Kurtz and Scott Johnson. 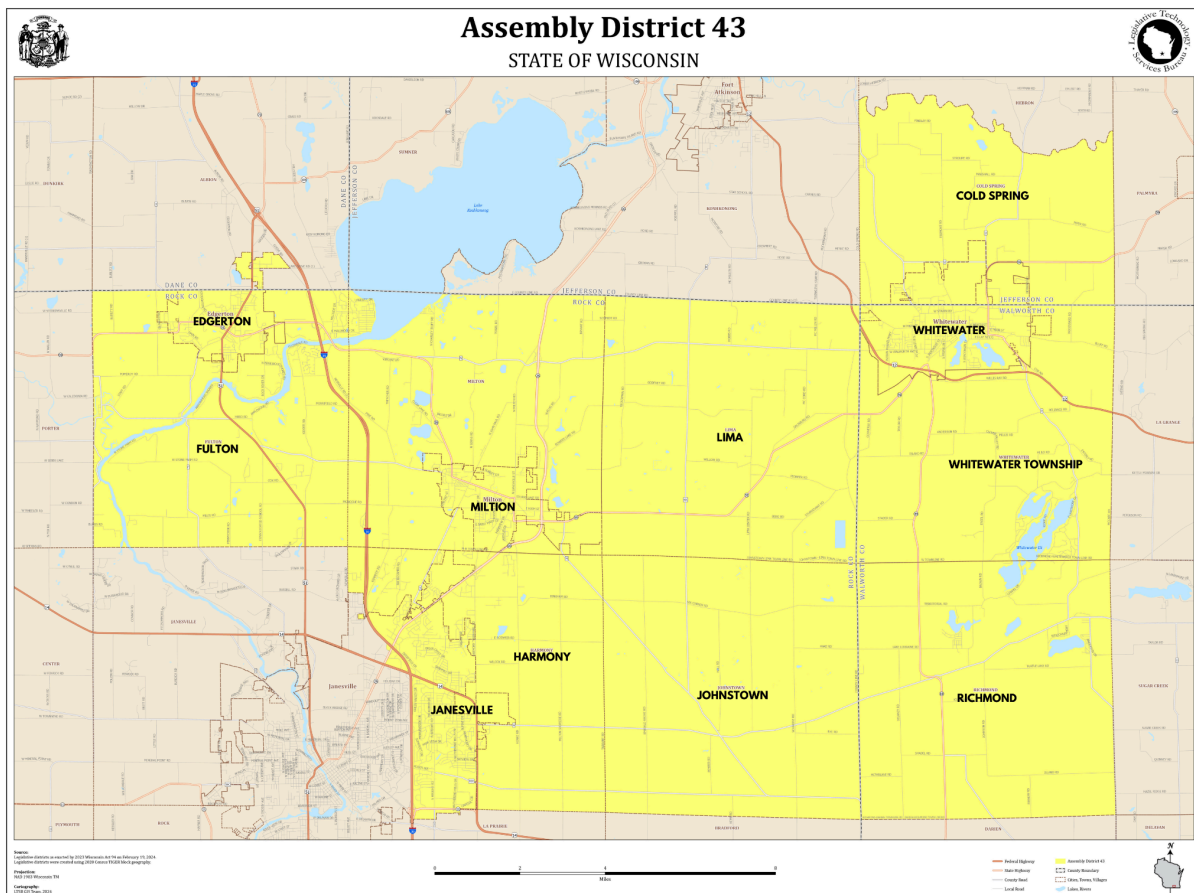

Brienne and friends canvassed out of the Whitewater office on Sunday, August 11th. (Brienne will personally be knocking on a minimum of 200 doors per week between now and election day, November 5th.)
