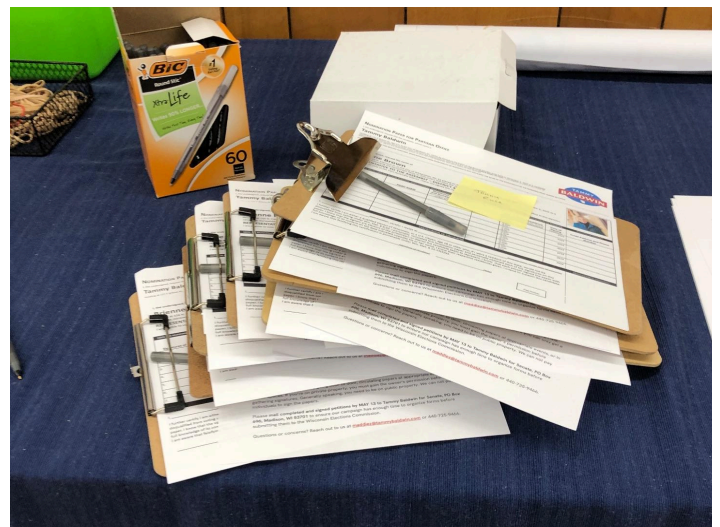

NEW DISTRICT BOUNDARIES ARE IN EFFECT FOR 2024 ELECTIONS:

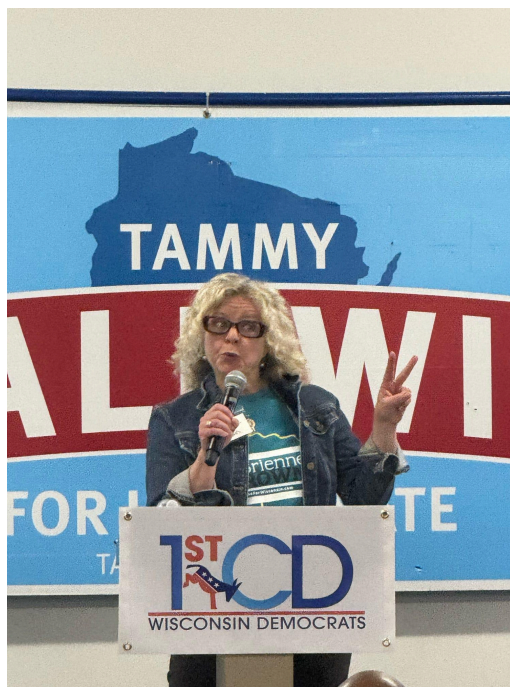
Not sure if you live in Brienne's district due to the new FAIR MAPS? Two ways to check:
