Platform Highlight: **VOTER PROTECTION**

As a former election volunteer, I know firsthand how rigorously municipal clerks and volunteer election inspectors check voter rolls and triple-check counts. Our citizens must believe in the process, too. This is why I want to ensure election officials and municipal clerks are well-funded so they can maintain oversight of our democratic processes.

I want to end gerrymandering, too. For decades, GOP lawmakers have forced gerrymandered districts upon the people, despite the majority of voters wanting and supporting non-partisan redistricting reform. Because of this, I have asked to include my name on the [Common Cause Wisconsin pro-reform candidates list](#). Common Cause Wisconsin is a non-partisan, non-profit organization that does not endorse any candidate for public office. But, by joining the State Assembly candidates listed on their website, I go on record that I will work in a non-partisan manner to build redistricting reform so the will of the people finally prevails. ~ Brienne
