A total of three volunteers came for our third trail work day of the season on the Cedar Brook Trail Extension which was held on a Friday.

The primary goal of the work day was to erect a kiosk that was removed from the Success Trail system. The kiosk was located at an intersection that is no longer on the Success trail system.

Contractors working on the Success Trail dismantled the kiosk and put it on a trailer owned by the NH Bureau of Trails. They then deliver the trailer to Berlin where it picked it up by Larry and transported it to the new parking area across from Pontook Dam.

Both Leo and Steve brought their tractors to the work day. Leo's tractor had a set of extended forks that were used to lift the heavy sign into position and Steve's tractor had a backhoe attachment that was used to dig the holes for the sign.

The entire job took about three hours and we send out our sincere thanks to these volunteers for their help on Friday.
