Another 4 Years For Current Buffalo Grove Trustees

It's easy to see why the old saying "if it ain't broke, don't fix it" applies to Buffalo Grove's current elected leaders.

It's also why the Journal & Topics endorses current trustees **Joanne Johnson**, **Les Ottenheimer** and **Denice Bocek** in the April 1 municipal election for Buffalo Grove village trustee.

There are four candidates running for four, four-year seats on the board.

All three current board members have been part of several accomplishments in the past few years from redeveloping Town Center into The Clove, to moving public works into a new building, to redevelopment of the former Rohrman car dealerships along Dundee Road, to name a few.

All three support strong fiscal management that protects taxpayer interests and have been part of a zero increase in the village tax levy for multiple years.
