comparing ourselves to others who would miss more "letters" in their "test." However, because of our sin nature, we all have distorted and blurry vision. We all need our vision tested by our Creator. And we all need corrective lenses through God's Word. Furthermore, we are incapable of seeing the whole picture, but He sees all. Third, a day will come when all Christ followers will see clearly with completely restored vision for all eternity in Heaven. How awesome is that?!
