Activities Center Renovation: "Bettering the Bridge" Pledge Campaign Activities & Dates

We are moving forward! Come this fall our activities center, which is a wonderful bridge to our community, will receive a much-needed facelift. This will enable it to be preserved in good shape and to continue being an effective tool of ministry and community interaction. I, Pastor Kevin, hope you find this exciting!

Details have been finalized for the loan we are receiving from Mercer County State Bank, a loan that was sought and set in place before interest rates recently went up. Now we must bind together and plan for paying this loan back as efficiently as possible, meeting the goal of paying back this twenty-year loan within five years. Yes, this appears to be a big task, especially in the face of our country's current inflation situation, but we have a HUGE and RESOURCEFUL God! This is no task for Him, especially when we bind together in prayerful dependance upon Him while sacrificially and faithfully giving toward this need. Personally, I am excited to see how God is going to provide as we partner together to work toward this goal of having an updated, welcoming, safe, and energy efficient space that is paid off as we faithfully trust Him. I expect Him to multiply our giving, grow our faith and unity, and even surprise us. Will you join in this journey with prayer and participation?

We have some important events regarding our building renovation preparedness **everyone needs to be** aware of and everyone needs to plan on attending.

- **Sunday, May 22: First Fruits Offering** during the worship service Before making a three year giving pledge individuals and families can make a one time offering beyond your regular tithes toward this project on this day.
- Sunday, May 22: Prayer Gathering in/around the Activities Center— Following the worship service we will spend some time praying collectively and individually over the building, the project, God's provision, ministries and activities within the building and pavilion (which is also being cemented), etc. We must ground who we are and everything we do in prayer, including a renovation project. Therefore, this is a vital gathering, and your participation is needed.
- **Sunday, June 5: Campaign Banquet** following the worship service We will gather in the Activities Center for a catered meal. We will also have a guest speaker who is well accustomed to successful church building projects, Pastor Ken Hough from Watson Run Church of God. Finally, we will write amounts we pledge to give beyond our regular tithes/offerings toward this project over a three-year

timespan. Even if you do not make a pledge, this gathering will be beneficial for everyone to receive information and be on the same page.

Saturday, Sept. 24: 3 on 3 Basketball Tournament Fundraiser – Pastor Kevin is planning to organize and run a 3 on 3 basketball tournament fundraiser as the last event in the Activities Center before renovations begin. This will be a way to notify the community, which uses our facility very much, of our project while providing a good community event. The goal would be to have at least twenty teams and to raise at least \$1,500. We may then have another such event in subsequent years, likely in the spring.



Pastor Kevin is going to have various emphases in Sunday messages over the coming months. May is going to start with a message titled "May I?" on God's will. While interrupted by a guest speaker's amazing testimony on May 15, he will then focus for a few weeks on godly giving. The summer months, which likely will include a guest speaker, are being developed around either/or a theme or a particular book of the Bible. By the end of the time this newsletter covers our Sunday messages will likely be covering the book of Acts and how we must follow the first church's example if we strive to be the CS First Church of God within God's design.



How about the wonderful performance our children gave us singing and dancing to the song "O Happy Day" on Easter?! Our church is blessed with amazing children! The number of children in our midst is growing, too. For example, on one recent Sunday morning we had 84 people in attendance with 22 of them being in elementary school or younger. Praise God for such an awesome ratio! As a church, we must be providing quality care for and connection with our children. We must be welcoming to young families while coming alongside them and helping them disciple their children. In order to do this we are going to be working toward some goals, including the following:

- Drywalling the nursery and updating the decorations in it
- Providing matching laminate flooring in the nursery and current children's ministry room (likely not until next year for the second room)
- Removing the barrier between the current children's ministry room and the kitchen to provide the children with more space
- Splitting children into two age groups in junior church on Sunday morning, which **requires at least a couple more committed volunteers.**
- Having a children's class at 9:30 on Sunday morning, which also requires another volunteer.


