


Stuff the Bus!

With the ebb and flow in our economic market, there are times when both physical and monetary resources can be stretched thin. This is a very real situation for Locker #505. As our Executive Director, Kim, explains, "One of our greatest fears at Locker #505 is turning students away because we don't have clothing in their size."

As you can see by the numbers, we have been busy helping hundreds of students this semester and serving thousands over the years. In November of last year, both our monetary and clothing donations dwindled, but the number of students we served continued to rise. During a particularly trying time, when we were at the bare minimum for certain sizes of shoes, Kim decided to use what little

money we had to purchase what was needed. As Kim went to check out she handed the clerk our tax-free card and the young woman inquired about what the items were for. Kim went on to explain Locker #505 and how we are a clothing bank for students in Bernalillo County. The young woman then asked if we had been located in portables before. Kim explained that we had been in the past and asked the young woman if she had ever utilized our services. With a smile on her face the clerk explained, "Yes! Every year for several years so that I wouldn't feel awkward going to school. Thank you!" Our gracious Kim smiled back and said, "You are welcome. I'm glad we could help."

The young clerk didn't know that the night before,

Kim had been pondering and praying about how to keep providing services and what the future held for Locker #505. By learning her story, Kim understood what her answer was. Even when times are tough, our mission to provide clothing for students in need will always be what drives us to serve our community. We may not always know how we will do it, but as the years have shown we will do it! That night helped all of us learn that even when we don't know what the future holds, we just need to have a little faith; which ironically was the young clerk's name.

Tips on Referring Students

- You can refer siblings who attend different schools, just please ensure each student has a separate referral form. For example, the referring party for an elementary school student can also refer siblings who are at other elementary, middle, or high schools as long as each student has a separate referral form.
- Gently remind parents and guardians that students are seen on a first come, first served basis. Sometimes we are full and have students waiting by 3:30pm. During busy times it may take until 5:00pm to finish properly clothing every student.
- If you need a referral form please contact us; we do not put it on our website. The latest form has been updated as of November 2016.
