National Autism Awareness Month

According to the Center for Disease Control (CDC), autism is the fastest growing developmental disability. In fact, the CDC reports that the prevalence of autism in U.S. children has increased by 119.4% from 2000 to 2010. In the year 2000 autism was formally diagnosed to 1 out of every 150 children. In 2010, the diagnosis rate jumped to 1 out of every 68 children. At this time there is no known single cause for autism, but as the Autism Society explains, "Researchers... are investigating a number of theories, including the links among heredity, genetics, and medical problems."

In working with students and their families, the staff and volunteers at Locker #505 want everyone to feel welcome and important when they walk through our doors. We know that parents may be concerned if their child has a learning disability or a sensory processing disability and how they might respond to coming to Locker #505. Our goal, with all students, is to meet them where they are and support them however we can. We understand that some students may need a person or an object with them as they are measured and pick out clothes so that they feel comfortable and secure. We know that some student may need a break during the process as well. Please know that Locker #505 is here to help every and all students and their families.
