# A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

It is hard to believe it is already October and we have seen 227 students since we opened on August 22. Let me translate that for you, it means we have given out at least 227 pairs of shoes, 1,362 pairs of socks and underwear, 681 pairs of jeans, and 227 hoodies/ jackets. This is why be need donations on a continuous basis, it is much like a revolving door; we constantly have clothing going out the door so we need to constantly be receiving donations, both in kind and financial. Our financial donations allow us to purchase not only the new socks, new under and new shoes, but a size of clothing that has not been donated. (i.e. no size 10 jeans have been donated and we need to have size 10 jeans in stock, so we purchase them) We attempt to keep size 4/5 to 52 waist and up to 4x in stock on a regular basis, since we never know what size students will come to visit.

October also brings an important fundraising event for Locker # 505 with the support of our good friends at the Sheraton Uptown on Menual and Louisiana. On Halloween evening from 5pm to 8pm the Sheraton Uptown will host the 6th Annual Scare-Aton including trick-or treating on the 2nd floor and an old fashion carnival with a Cake Walk, free to the public. The fundraising comes from the hotel rooms sold to businesses, organizations and individuals for \$150, where they can give out candy (provided) and information about their business. You can decorate your door and area in the hall and after trick- ortreating is complete you can relax and spend the night in your room. We can even provide a volunteer to hand your candy and information out if you are unavailable to attend but

This was a student-centered facility where children could try on clothes in comfortable and welcoming surroundings aided by caring and knowledgeable employees and volunteers. When the BCCPTA Clothing Bank closed its doors in 2013, a great resource for children was lost to the Bernalillo County community. Locker #505 was founded in 2014 to once again provide a student-centered clothing facility for children in need where they can find loving assistance in choosing appropriate school clothing.
