Our last day to see students will be May 16th– don't wait until the last minute to get those referrals in!

Isotopes Concession Volunteers Needed!

The Isotopes again this year has given Locker #505 the opportunity to fund-raise by working the concession during games. This year the New Mexico United Soccer team will also have their games at Isotopes Park so this will give us additional opportunities. We are in need of more volunteers or volunteer groups (church, office, sports, friends) to ensure we can make the most of this opportunity. Locker #505 receives a portion of the proceeds from each game we work. Typically volunteers must arrive a minimum of an hour prior to game time and must be 16 years old. The shift is between 3 to 4 hours depending on the length of game and the concession stand we are placed in. You will be on your feet the majority of the time so comfortable shoes will be a must. We also need alcohol servers which you can obtain online by going to <http://www.servsafe.com/access/ss/Catalog/ProductList/107>, there is a \$30 cost, but it is good for 3 years.

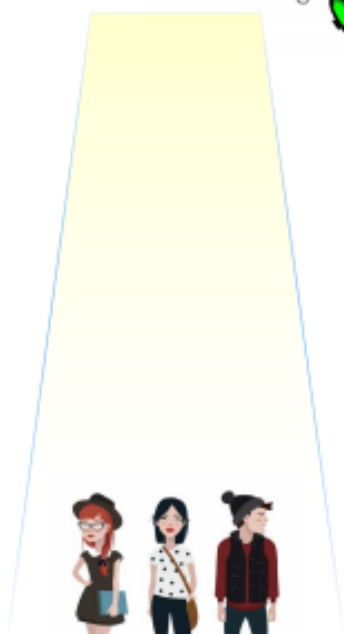
