## **Sponsor a Child Donations Doubled**

Locker #505 has been given a matching grant from The Anderson Foundation for \$10,000 for our Sponsor A Child campaign. This means that if we raise \$10,000, The Anderson Foundation will give us an additional \$10,000. Basically it's like doubling your donation to our Sponsor a Child campaign. It cost \$150 to clothe a child for one visit, and each child receives five pairs of new underwear, eight pairs of new socks, one pair of new shoes, one coat or jacket and five outfits consisting of new and gently used clothing that they select. In order to clothe a student for an entire year (three visits), the cost is \$450. In addition to the clothing, the students also receive hygiene products, school supplies, a backpack, books to read, a toy and a stuffed animal.
