## A MESSAGE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

Well, the 2020-2021 school year has begun in a way that none of us would have thought of a year ago, but here we are. We understand that many decisions, events, and programs up in the air, but Locker \#505 : Students Clothing Bank is back and serving students curbside. We feel that even though most students are currently attending school online, they still need clothing that fits well and is in good condition allowing them to focus on their education.

Referrals are now sent directly to Locker \#505 and our staff calls the parent to obtain sizes and preferences of the student. Clothing is then put together for the student including: new underwear, new socks, new shoes, a jacket and up to 4 outfits. Parents are given an appointment to come and pick
up the student's clothing curbside, keeping everyone safe and healthy.

For our wonderful and devoted donors we continue to need donations both financial and in-kind allowing us to continue to serve the students in need throughout Bernalillo County from Kindergarten through 12th grade. See our Wish List in this newsletter for in-kind donations needed.

Fundraisers will continue to be difficult due to a variety of COVID-19 restrictions and the uncertainty we are experiencing makes it difficult to make plans. Among the challenge of changing our process to allow students to be seen, we were broken into twice in 3 months leaving us without two computers, printers, numerous shoes, and a great deal of underwear. ## FOREGO YOUR CUP OF JOE!

Covid-19 has made it difficult for us to have fundraisers, at this point we were unable to have a Spring Fashion Show, and now our Fall Scare-aton at the Sheraton will be canceled as
well. Non-profits depend greatly on the kindness and generosity of others, but without these opportunities to support us, it can make it difficult to know when and how to donate. Locker\# 505 now has an easy way for you to support the children of Bernalillo County. It costs Locker \# 505 between $\$ 75$ and $\$ 100$ to clothe a student for the semester. Our new program "Forego Your Cup of Joe" asks you, your family, your friends, and your coworkers, to skip your cup of daily coffee, regular cocktail, or other daily drink once a week or more and make a reoccurring donation to Locker \# 505. For example, if you spend $\$ 5$ a day on a drink, you can set that aside and make a monthly donation of approximately $\$ 20$, or any amount you are comfortable with. You can make this donation through our website https://locker505.org/ monetary-donations and mark
the box that says "Make this a monthly donation." Having reoccurring donations allows us the ability to plan better for the number of students we can serve and how we can serve them. We would greatly appreciate anything you are able to donate.
