Animals as Tools

- ✦ Whales
 - ✦ Oil: lamps
 - ✦ Baleen: umbrellas, buggy whips, fishing rods, and hair brushes
 - ✦ Teeth: Carved into with inscriptions and decorations
 - ✦ Bone: stays in corsets
- ✦ Otter: pelts
- ✦ Mammoths
 - ✦ Used Antlers, tusks, hides
- ✦ Mollusks
 - ✦ Cooking pots
 - ✦ Bowls
 - ✦ Utensils (cutlery made from bivalves)
 - ✦ Storage containers for various household products
- ✦ Walruses
 - ✦ Tusks: Ice axes, various other tools
 - ✦ Hides obtained shelter, boats, sleds and clothing
 - ✦ Oil
- ✦ Sea lions
 - ✦ Hides: clothing and boat materials
- ✦ Seals
 - ✦ Oil
 - ✦ Pelts
- ✦ Sea turtles
 - ✦ Oil
 - ✦ Bones: tools.
 - ✦ Various body parts: medicine
 - ✦ Shell's scutes: combs, brushes, cigarette boxes, jewelry, hair ornaments
- ✦ Polar bears
 - ✦ Fur
 - ✦ Meat
 - ✦ Medicines
- ✦ Bones in General
 - ✦ Flutes
 - ✦ Tools
 - ✦ Knives
 - ✦ Fish hooks
 - ✦ Hoes
 - ✦ Bracelets
 - ✦ Wrenches
- ✦ Various Reef organisms: Medicinal purposes
