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By my signature here and below, I acknowledge that:

1. I understand that it is irresponsible for an animal rescue to return animals to an unsafe situation where they will face strong chance of harm to their well-being. The rescue will **not** return an animal to a situation in which any of the following are present: 1) evidence of the deprivation of food, water, or safe shelter involving the animal(s), 2) evidence of dog-fighting, cock-fighting, or other unlawful animal-based bloodsport, bait animals, or bait-based hunting, 3) the intention to utilize the animal(s) in question in the production of meat, fur, or other product consumables involving direct harm or death of the animal(s) for either personal or commercial usage, 4) evidence that the animal(s) would be at risk of harm by physical violence, lack of shielding or shelter from predators, or used for unlawful breeding or exploitive practices.
2. If the rabbit(s) in question are found by or currently in the care of the rescue, any expense for the health of the rabbit(s) incurred by the rescue including medical supplies used, veterinary exams, treatments, and surgical operations necessary for the rabbit(s) are **MY** financial responsibility. In this case, the expense total provided by the rescue invoice to me is expected to be reimbursed to the rescue prior to the return of the rabbit(s).
